The Master of Professional Accounting is perfect if you're a young professional or have recently graduated in another field.

In this degree, you'll cover the full spectrum of business, financial and management accounting – giving you a broad understanding that'll complement your other studies. You'll also spend time learning the latest business practices while developing a more general professional skill set.

Course structure

The course is structured in three parts. Part A. Advanced preparatory studies, Part B. Mastery knowledge and Part C. Application studies. All students complete Part A, B and C.

This degree will strengthen your CV for any business role, working alongside other studies to give you a more comprehensive picture of the way businesses operate across public, private and government sectors. You'll also be qualified to take an accounting role, and could be eligible for exemptions when joining a number of accounting regulatory bodies.

Accreditation and professional recognition

By studying this course you may be eligible for exemptions toward Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA) papers, associate membership and entry to the CPA Program of CPA Australia, entry to the Chartered Accountants Program of Chartered Accountants Australia and New Zealand, and associate membership of the Institute of Public Accountants.
